

## **Login instructions**

We inform you that the on-line “**Training course for safety and health in the workplace - general safety training**” for Workers and Visitors to the University of Eastern Piedmont is available.

This course allows you to know the organization of corporate security, the concepts of risk, damage, prevention and the related behavior to be taken in order to protect our and our colleagues’ safety and health.

The certificate, complete with all the data required by the Law (including the organizer of the course, reference legislation, personal data), represents a permanent formative credit.

## **Targets**

The course provides general information that is necessary to understand the organizational structure of the system of protection, safety and health at work set up at the University.

## **How to access the platform**

- log in with your University credentials (*Attention please: without an email account @uniupo.it it is not possible to access the course*)
- in "ricerca corsi" (“search courses”) enter the string **general safety training**
- select the most recent edition of the Course **2023/2024 Training course for safety and health in the workplace - general safety training**
- Start the Course by following the instructions on the screen

## **Organization of the Course**

The course consists of 7 modules plus an introductory module.

The display of each individual module is bound as the next module is not accessible if the previous one has not been completed in all its parts.

Each module, excluding the introductory module and the module 7, include a self-assessment test: although they are mandatory and part of the learning process, these tests do not involve any evaluation by the Tutors: these tests can be repeated without limits, to access the next module a score equal to or higher than 80% of-correct answers is required.

The course ends with a "final learning check" that is mandatory for all participants: this verification has a maximum duration of 30 minutes and consists of 24 questions. You must answer exactly at least 75% of the questions (so at least 18 correct answers) to pass it: if the test is not passed, you can try again 24 hours after the conclusion of the previous attempt.

Only after carrying out all the planned activities, following the video lessons, downloading the files, passing the self-learning tests for the 7 modules and passing the "Final learning check", it will be possible to view and download in pdf format your Certificate of Participation in the Course (we suggest you to save the file in a safe place in order to provide it in the future).

Please note that this course is mandatory, therefore any failure to access the platform will have to be justified.
